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2. What is IdiomBridge™?

IdiomBridge™ is an AI-powered language learning companion built around two core experiences:

■ Search

Type any idiom, expression, slang or saying into the search box and IdiomBridge™ instantly finds the culturally equivalent expression — not a literal translation, but the phrase a native speaker would actually use. Every result includes cultural meaning, origin, grammar analysis, real-world context and natural examples. The **Go Deeper** feature reveals the full cultural story behind every expression. Exploring how different cultures express the same idea is genuinely fascinating — and students who discover this become more curious and engaged language learners.

■ Study

The Study Hub transforms expressions into active learning. Flashcards, Quiz Mode, Practice in Context, Pronunciation Practice and curated Collections turn passive knowledge into genuine fluency. The **Expression Guides** — 770+ of the most commonly used expressions across Italian, French, Spanish and English — are fully searchable and each one fires directly into the search experience with a single tap.

IdiomBridge™ is not a replacement for your teaching — it is a powerful reinforcement.

3. Who is it for?

IdiomBridge™ works best for students at A2 level and above:

Level	How to use IdiomBridge™
A2 Elementary	Use sparingly. Focus on the most common daily expressions from the Expression Guides. One expression per lesson via the Idiom of the Day. Avoid Go Deeper at this stage — cultural detail can overwhelm beginners.
B1 Intermediate	The sweet spot for IdiomBridge™. Students have enough vocabulary to appreciate cultural context. Introduce Go Deeper, In Context and the Expression Guides. Quiz Mode works well as a low-pressure warm-up activity.
B2+ Advanced	Students can use IdiomBridge™ independently. Assign Expression Guide browsing as homework. Use Practice in Context for sophisticated conversation practice. Go Deeper's cultural origin and regional notes become genuinely fascinating at this level.

4. Key Features for Educators

Search The core feature. Search any expression in 16 languages and get the culturally equivalent phrase. Use this live when a student asks 'what does that really mean?'	Go Deeper Reveals cultural origin, regional variations, formality level, grammar analysis and natural examples. Turn a quick search into a rich cultural conversation.

5. Ready-to-Use Lesson Activities

Activity 1 — The Warm-Up (5 minutes)

Best for: A2 and above

Start every lesson with the Idiom of the Day. Ask your student: 'Have you seen today's idiom? Do you know what it means?' Search it together — explore the cultural origin, the Go Deeper section and the example sentence. Five minutes of genuine cultural immersion before the lesson even begins.

Activity 2 — Student-Led Discovery (homework)

Best for: B1 and above

Before the next lesson, ask your student to browse the Expression Guides and pick 5 expressions they have heard but never fully understood. In the next session search each one together — discuss the cultural context, practice pronunciation and use Quiz Mode to test retention. Students arrive engaged because they chose the content themselves.

Activity 3 — The Deep Dive (15 minutes)

Best for: B1 and above

When a student uses an idiom incorrectly or asks 'what does that expression really mean?' — search it instantly. Go Deeper reveals cultural origin, regional variations, formality level and natural examples. Turn a correction moment into a rich cultural conversation.

Tuesday	Student browses Expression Guide and picks 3 expressions to explore	<i>Expression Guides</i>
Wednesday	Search and explore chosen expressions — cultural deep dive	<i>Search + Go Deeper</i>
Thursday	Quiz Mode — test this week's expressions	<i>Quiz Mode</i>
Friday	Practice in Context — use expressions naturally in conversation	<i>Practice in Context</i>
